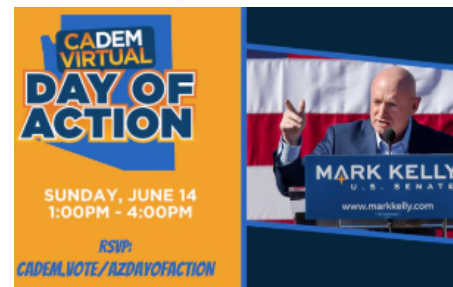
- The response to the Postcard campaign was excellent: thanks to all who volunteered;

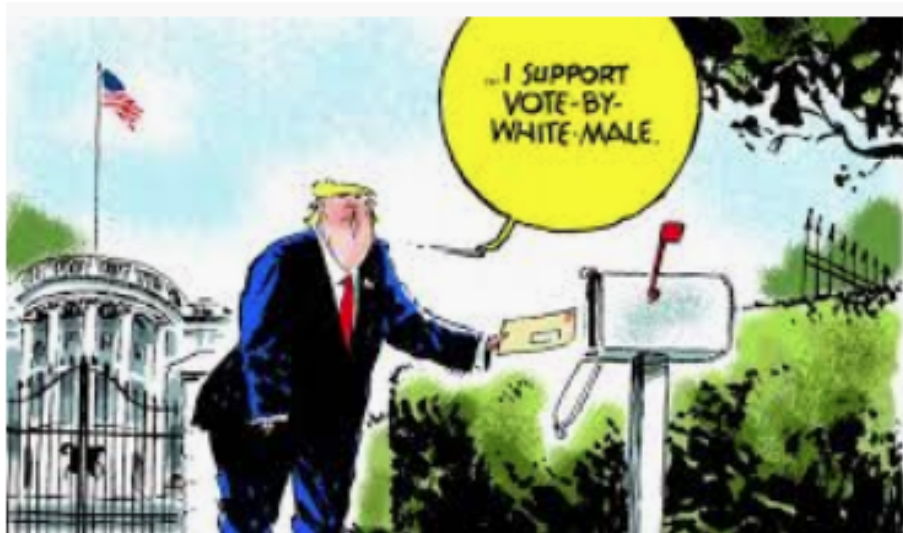
Cheri Greven was the speaker at our April General Meeting.
We just received this request from her:

"I wanted to follow up about one of the items I spoke about in the presentation to your group, the June Medical v. Russo Supreme Court decision expected soon. It could potentially decimate abortion access across the country. In an effort to illustrate why access to safe and legal abortion is so important, we will be sharing abortion stories from multiple generations on our PP blog, through letters to the editor and media interviews.

Is it possible to send a call to action to your group asking for people to share their abortion stories, if they have them? I will work with each storyteller on how best to use their story based on their own comfort level whether it's anonymous or public. We wouldn't share the story in any capacity without the storyteller's permission."
