Hundreds Protest Medicaid Cuts at Kiley's Office

The Fund Care, Not Billionaires Day of Action organized by National Nurses United drew hundreds to Kevin Kiley's Rocklin office on July 1st. Chants of "Healthcare, Not Wealthcare" and "Fund Care, Not Billionaires" could be heard as protesters gathered and marched along

Lonetree Blvd. Speakers stressed how the Medicaid cuts in Trump's "Big Ugly Bill" to fund the government will undermine our entire healthcare system. Thanks to all the Lincoln Dems who came out. Unfortunately, our protests fell on deaf ears. The budget reconciliation bill was passed by Congress with Kiley's support on July 3rd.

Here's what **Robert Hubbell**, author of Today's Edition on Substack, has to say about the "Big Ugly Bill":

"The passage of the reconciliation bill is a painful loss. The loss was personal on multiple levels. Many of you rallied in the streets, called your representatives, attended town halls, donated, made phone calls, and wrote letters and postcards. For others, the loss is personal because they will face new levels of financial, food, and medical insecurity. It is right to feel anger and disappointment.



But not despair. Tens of millions of Americans are by your side in the battle to preserve democracy and retake control of Congress and the presidency. We can and will undo much of the damage inflicted in the Big Ugly Bill if


THINK YOUR MEDICARE IS SAFE? Sequestration

"The One Big Beautiful Bill Act also known as congressional republican's budget reconciliation bill—would cause AUTOMATIC cuts to MEDICARE payment to the tune of \$535 BILLION over the next nine years, harming providers, forcing hospital closures (especially in rural areas) and raising costs for everyone. This would force a Sequestration.

These enormous Medicare cuts are the result of a rule Congress set for itself in Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010, known as "PAYGO." If the scorecard indicates more costs than savings, the president must order the **Sequestration** of enough funds from mandatory programs to balance the books. It's a Wrap – Sierra College Voter registration. What Young People are Saying!

Did you know that the <u>Auburn Area Democratic Club</u> conducts voter registration at Sierra College throughout the school year? They also take a pulse on how the students are feeling about politics and government. Here's some thoughts

pulse on how the students are feeling about politics and government. Here's some thoughts from them:

In total, we registered 168 students. All but 14 registrations occurred in the fall semesterwhen election energy was high.

Many students continue to shun party affiliation and register as No Party Preference. They do, however, lean strongly democratic, so we continue to spend time and energy getting them to the ballot box. On one survey, we asked how students feel President Trump did on key topics in his first 100 days in office this term, and we provided 5 choices: **Great, Good, The Same, Worse, Much Worse.**

Of the 50 responses to the question, "How is Trump doing on the Economy?" 8 answered Worse, and 32 answered Much Worse. One survey taker told us we needed a choice that was far stronger than Much Worse!

Students were most concerned about the threat to habeas corpus and the cuts to SNAP, Medicaid and other safety net programs to provide tax cuts for millionaires and billionaires. (Aren't we all!)

Students will return to Sierra College campus for the fall semester (the third week of August) and once again, they will find the AADC Voter Registration teams conducting our signature surveys and encouraging them to vote!

Luncheon is limited to 100 people. Details will be sent out as plans develop.


